Our 5th Graders traveled to the Minnesota Discovery Center this week. They enjoyed the weather and sites and learning on this field trip



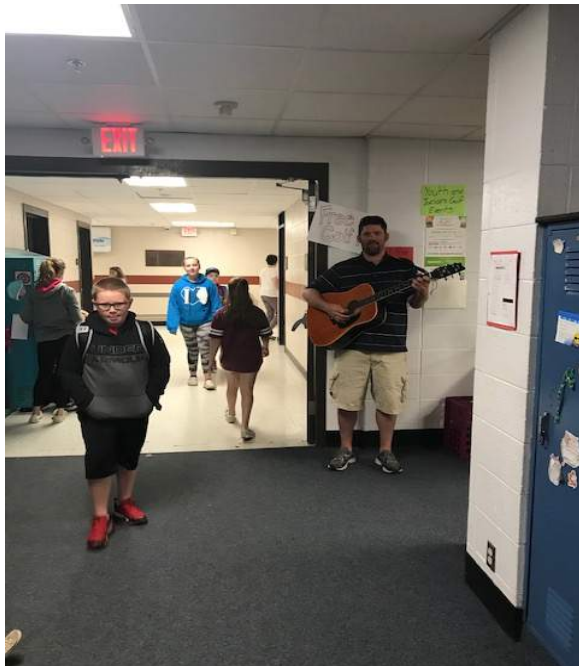
The Children's Center held their End of Year Carnival last night with a great attendance of kids,



parents and staff!

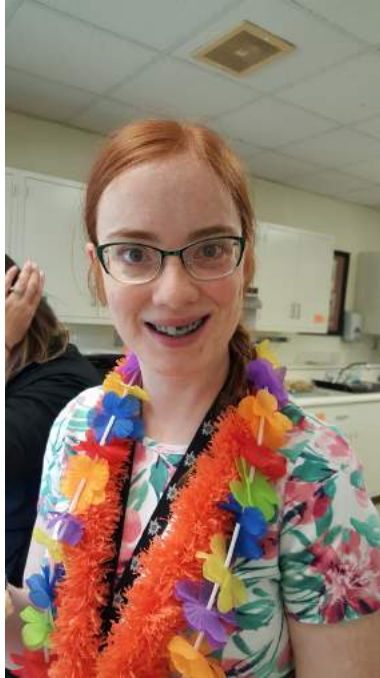


At Rippleside Elementary, this is how Mr. Statz greets our students in the morning.... with a little music! What an inspirational perk! Thank you, Mr. Statz!
