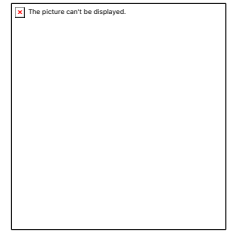

Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE)



What is ECFE?

Class Name: Multi-age ECFE Class

Description: *A time for adults (parents, grandparents, caregivers, etc.) and children to come to school together!* This class is designed for adults and children 18 months through pre-kindergarten age. In the multi-age ECFE class, adults and children engage in crafts & games, a short circle, and snack. Snack is followed by adult discussion led by a parent educator in a separate room while children engage in structured play with center staff. Choose from one of two weekly classes below:

Age: Classes are designed for learners from 18 months to prekindergarten age

Time: 10:00 am - 11:30 am (choose one of these sessions)
5:15 pm - 6:45 pm

Dates: October 1st thru December 17th (Mondays only)

Fees: Class fees vary from \$24 - \$60

No family will be turned away for an inability to pay

Class begins with activities such as crafts and games that adults and children do together. These activities have been designed by a licensed Early Childhood Teacher. Activities enhance children's learning and give parents ideas of skills to work on at home.

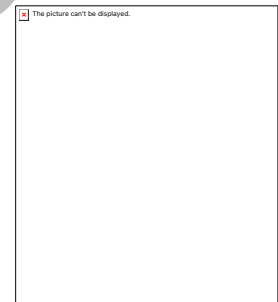
Discussion Time



Adults participate in a discussion led by a licensed parent educator. Discussions are based on adults' interests as well as Minnesota's Core Curriculum.

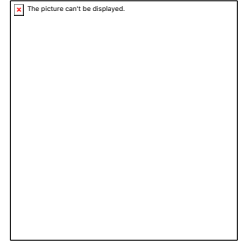

While adults are in discussion group, children learn through structured play activities led by an Early Childhood Teacher. Structured play helps children grow and develop socially, emotionally & cognitively, as well as enhance their communication and motor skills.

Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE)



What is ECFE?

Class name: Non-Separating ECFE Class

Description: *A time for adults (parents, grandparents, caregivers, etc.) and children to come to school together!* This class is designed for adults and toddlers (12-24 months of age) who are not quite ready to separate. A typical class would include together time, circle time, snack, and adult discussion. Adult-child interaction will give you a chance to spend some uninterrupted time together participating in developmentally appropriate crafts, games, and activities. Adult discussion led by a licensed parent educator will move to a section of the room while staff continue to assist your children in exploring the classroom and all it has to offer.

Age: Classes are designed for learners from 12 months to 24 months of age (Siblings are welcome, but reminder there is no sibling care provided)

Time: 8:15am - 9:30am

Dates: October 1st thru December 17th (Mondays only)

Fees: Class fees vary from \$24 - \$60
