TO: The Graduating Class and Parents:

The last day of regular senior classes will be Thursday, May 21st. The senior class trip will be Friday, May 22nd and graduation is on Friday, May 29th. Due to the relative closeness of these dates, the senior advisors and administration wish to express our concern that this year's class trip to Breezy Point will not cast a shadow over graduation for any senior.

The class trip at Aitkin High School is a school-sanctioned event. It is one more learning experience offered to all seniors; a day of fun and relaxation. From the time of departure at approximately 9:00 a.m. (by bus only) until the return to the high school (by bus only), all seniors participating are under the care and supervision of the high school. Any rules pertaining to student conduct, drinking, drugs, etc. will be dealt with as taking place during school time. Upon returning to the school, at approximately 5:45 p.m., these students will NOT be under the supervision or the responsibility of the school.

We ask for your cooperation and support in the enforcement of these rules. The advisors will exercise the right to enforce the rules by referring the student to the administration or other authorities.
