February 22, 2019 Aitkin 49 Staples 16

The Aitkin Gobbler Girls JV Basketball Team finished their season strong with a 49-16 win over Staples at home Friday night. Aitkin overcame 25 turnovers by dominating the boards (48 Team Rebounds), shooting 35% from the field and playing lockdown defense to hold Staples to 16 points.

On the defensive end, Sarah McMillan led the team with 3 pass deflections. Teagan Piecek and Kendra Grulhke each grabbed 4 steals to lead Aitkin and Noelle Jones blocked 2 shots.

McMillan grabbed 15 rebounds, Jones collected 14 rebounds and Grulhke added 7 boards.
