



Canvas is the online learning platform that your child will use from Early Childhood through 12th grade. Parents should have received instructions about setting up a parent observer account. By setting up this account, ALL parents will be able to view lessons and content that are being covered in class. This account will become even more crucial if the district moves into a different educational model.
